Actions

At Terra Arts, it is our policy to support all styles of learning within respectful boundary zones of behavior. In light of those truths, we have established a simple protocol that will be followed to ensure our learning environment is secure and productive for all. (We want to acknowledge that everyone has bad days too, and grace is granted to each individual ; assuming the best of one another in all circumstances before making accusations.)

Easy as 1 - 2 - 3

1	Students are given verbal reminders from teacher to correct disruptive behavior. (This is very effective & will typically end the distraction)
2	If the disruptive behavior continues the parents/guardians are notified of the behavior. ("Oops!" Report)
3	If the behavior continues after discussions with the parents/guardian, then the parent will be asked to join the following week of classes for the entire day to supervise the student.
