



CLASSROOM VISITATION POLICY

PLEASE FOLLOW ALL VISITOR POLICIES FOUND BELOW

Thank you for offering to support your student in the classroom as an **Educational Aide**.

We value parent and community involvement at Terra Arts and appreciate your partnership in creating a positive learning environment. Educational Aide opportunities are available in TK through 8th grade across all drop-off programs.

If your student has been disruptive in any class, we might have requested that you attend as a **Behavior Aide**.

In this role, your goal is to support your student in understanding and meeting classroom expectations.

The following policies apply to all classroom visitors:

Please note: We are not a public or private school; we are a learning center.

Our policies may differ from those you are familiar with.

1. Visitation Approval & Campus Access

- All classroom visits must be requested and approved in advance, in writing.
- Terra Arts is a limited public forum. As such, access to classrooms and campus is restricted and subject to administrative approval.
- All visitors must sign in and out daily and wear a visible visitor badge at all times.
- Visitors may not bring unenrolled children onto campus without prior authorization.
 - Unenrolled children may not participate in classroom activities.

2. Privacy & Safety

- Photography or video recording of staff or students is strictly prohibited without prior authorization.
- Please inform the Director of any relevant student needs. This information will be kept confidential and used only to support your student.
- Non-staff adults may not enter student restrooms. Only a parent or guardian may assist their Kindergarten-aged child in the restroom. Students may not use adult restrooms.

3. Classroom Expectations

- Please sit with your student or in a designated area unless otherwise directed.
- Do not answer questions directed to students or engage the teacher in private conversation during instruction.
- Refrain from talking with students or adults during class time, including phone use.
- Do not complete your student's work, correct it directly, or take materials from them.
- If needed, you may demonstrate an example on a separate sheet of paper for your student to reference.
- Model respectful, attentive, and supportive behavior at all times.

4. Student Participation

- Students are expected to participate in all classroom activities.
- Exceptions may be made in the following situations:
 - A student needs a break due to sensory discomfort (such as sound or smell)
 - A student is unable to participate in physical activity
 - A student opts out of animal dissection (an alternative assignment will be provided when applicable)

5. Disruptions & Conduct

- Visitors are expected to leave the premises once the student is no longer receiving assistance in the classroom.
- Terra Arts is committed to maintaining a safe, secure, and peaceful learning environment.
- If a visitor disrupts classroom instruction or campus operations, they may be asked to stop the behavior or leave campus immediately.
- Failure to comply may result in removal from campus and possible involvement of law enforcement.
