



## WITHDRAWAL POLICY

**PLEASE NOTE: ONE POLICY SIGNING IS NEEDED PER FAMILY EACH ACADEMIC YEAR**

I acknowledge to Terra Classical Theater, Inc. ("Terra Arts") that I understand the withdrawal policy (also known as the drop policy).

**I understand that enrollment in the Foundations, Thinker, or Doer Day Program at Terra Arts is a year-long commitment, spanning 30 weeks from September to May of the academic year.**

I understand that families are responsible for paying the full balance for the academic year regardless of attendance if a withdrawal occurs **after the July 1st drop date**, unless my student falls into one of the following categories:

- My student is being enrolled in a public or private school and/or homeschooling is completely discontinued.
- My student has a serious medical condition that prevents attendance.
- My family is moving more than 50 miles from Terra Arts.

If I fall into any of the above categories, I agree to provide supporting documentation of these changes to Terra Arts. In this case, I understand I am only responsible for paying for the next 30 days of classes per the billing cycle. After which, I would no longer be financially responsible for the remainder of the academic year.

**For afternoon courses**, I understand that families are required to pay by the semester of enrollment. Withdrawals are only allowed at the end of the first semester. In this case, I am only responsible for paying for the first semester. After which, if a withdrawal occurs mid-semester, I understand that I am still financially responsible for the full semester's fees.

**If I enroll mid-year**, I agree to the terms of this withdrawal policy, which apply starting from the date I register for the current academic year. I will also be financially responsible for all program fees from the date of registration through the Terra Arts website.

**I understand that if I am enrolling mid-year, billing will begin on the date I register.** For example, if I enroll in January but do not plan to have my student attend until March, I understand I am financially responsible for all program fees starting in January, as if my student began attending in January.
